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Standing Committees Regulations

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Citation

1. This Regulation may be cited as the Standing Committees Regulations.

Interpretation

2. In this Regulation, unless it is otherwise provided or the context otherwise requires, all words shall have the meanings given in the Constitution of the National University of Singapore Students' Union.

Amendment

3. A Motion seeking to amend or remove any provision of this Regulation shall not be passed unless it has been supported by the votes of:
 - (1) Not less than half of the total number of Voting Council Representatives present during a Council Meeting, or
 - (2) Not less than half of the total number of Union Members present during a General Meeting of the Union.
4. For the purposes of section 3, amendment of provisions includes addition, amendment or repealing of provisions.

Legislative History

- 4A. This Regulation was first enacted on 4 August 2012 and amended on 5 February 2014, 18 June 2016, 28 October 2018, and 25 May 2019.

Standing Committees

5. There shall be the following Standing Committees:
 - (1) The Finance Committee
 - (2) The Publication Committee
 - (3) The Student Welfare Committee
 - (4) Any committee created by the Council for the term

The Finance Committee

6. The Finance Committee shall consist of the following:
 - (1) The Financial Secretary who shall be the ex-officio Chairman of the Committee;
 - (2) The President of the Union who shall be an ex-officio member;



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- (3) Three other members, elected by Council Representatives. The Committee shall elect a secretary from among its own members.
7. The duties of the Finance Committee shall be:
 - (1) to keep the records and documents of NUS projects that have applied for the NUSSU Council Funding
 - (2) to be the administrative body to see through the projects that have qualified for the NUSSU Council Funding
 - (3) to review and make appropriate recommendation to the Council or the Executive Committee regarding any financial matters.

The Publication Committee

8. The Publication Committee shall consist of the following:
 - (1) The Communications Secretary who shall be the ex-officio Chairman of the Committee;
 - (2) Not more than two other members, elected by Council Representatives. The Committee shall elect a secretary from among its own members.
9. The duties of the Publication Committee shall be:
 - (1) to implement the Union's policies on publications of the Union;
 - (2) to co-ordinate the work of all publications emanating from the Union;
10. The Publication Policy shall be as follows:
 - (1) All publications shall reflect the aims and objectives of the Union;
 - (2) No matters of policy may be published without written directive from the Council.

The Student Welfare Committee

11. The Student Welfare Committee shall consist of the following:
 - (1) The Student Welfare Secretary who shall be the ex-officio Chairman of the Committee;
 - (2) Four members, who are not Executive Committee Members, elected by Council Representatives. The Committee shall elect from among its own members a Secretary and a Treasurer.
12. The duties of the Student Welfare Committee shall be:
 - (1) be responsible for bringing to the notice of the Council any problem affecting the welfare of the Union's members that may arise within the University;
 - (2) recommend to the Council such course of action as may be taken for the purpose of alleviating student welfare problems within the University and implement such decisions of the Union.
13. The Student Welfare Committee shall have powers to:



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- (1) appoint sub-committees for the purpose of assisting the committee in the execution of its duties.

General

14. Any standing committees created under 5(4):
 - (1) shall present its composition and duties to the Council for approval at the earliest possible Council Meeting.
 - (2) shall consist of at least three (3) members of the Council to be formed.
 - (3) have the power to appoint sub-committees for the purpose of assisting the committee in the execution of its duties.
 - (4) must be reviewed and voted by the next Council to continue its work for another term. If the earlier is approved, the composition and duties of the standing committee will require the approval of the new Council.
15. All standing committees have the responsibility to update the Council on its work at each Council Meeting and present a final report at the last Council Meeting.
